



Sampark is an initiative of Team A4 to help first-year students prepare for summer internship placements. Sampark provides a platform where students can interact with alumni and learn about the subtleties of the industry, which will assist them in moulding their corporate journey further. Students were mapped to the alumni who work in the domain of their interests. This way, students were able to measure their preparation and identify the improvement areas for the summer internship placements according to the feedback.

SAMPARK IX

Sampark IX was organized from 9th 2021. September to 18th September Sampark included mock personal interviews or interactive sessions for 170 first-vear students guided by 60+ alumni, ranging from the very first batch of PGP and PGPX to the recent graduates, who have vast experience in the industry and are in the highest positions in prominent organizations. They provided helpful and valuable feedback to students and offered relevant suggestions to perform well in the summer internship. The alumni gave their precious time to first-year students to assist and gauge their preparation for the first big step towards the placements. In the past, Sampark had benefited the students secure a decent summer placement. Sampark facilitated interaction between the first years and the IIMU Alumni, creating a comprehensive atmosphere of fraternity. Since the beginning, the IIMU community has worked as a family, and Team A4 is proud to organize such events further to reinforce this bond.



The alumni were open and pleasant in responding to students' questions. Also, the students were thrilled and excited with the alumni interaction. The program gave halt to their trepidations about the job market and assisted them in thinking clearly and rationally about the process involved in the SIP process. The event bridged the gap between students and alumni, providing a guide to the students for a lifetime.

THE PROCESS

INTEREST GATHERING

The first phase started with rolling out the interest form for first-year students and the alumni community, seeking their interest for a one-on-one session to gauge the preparedness of the batch. 170 students and 60+ alumni showed their interest to participate in the event. The form also collected data on the domain and availability of alumni.

DATA MAPPING & INTERACTION SCHEDULE

In the second phase, alumni were mapped with a group of students based on their preferences. The interactions were scheduled as per the availability of both the alumni and the students. Students' resume was shared with the alumni, and interaction was arranged through various virtual platforms. Also, some interaction took place through telephonic conversation.

INTERACTION SESSION


The third phase was the one-on-one interaction between the students with their mapped alumni. The interaction happened in different forms for different people based on the discretion of alumni and students. For some, it was in the form of an interview with a mix of hygiene questions, case-based questions and guesstimates and for the others in a form of informal interactions where the alumni resolved their general queries.

FEEDBACK

In the last phase, alumni gave extensive feedback to the students, ranging from CV, preparation level, improvement areas, and resolved their domain-specific queries. Firstyear students utilized this opportunity to clarify their doubts about the SIP process and career options. The alumni were very supportive and answered all the queries with utmost sincerity. Also, both alumni and students submitted a feedback form to gauge how the program could be improved.
