### **SAMPARK**

Sampark is team A4's initiative for helping PGP1 students towards their preparation of summer internship placements. It is a platform where the students can interact with the alumni and get to know the actual nuances of the industry which will help them in carving out their career path. The students are mapped with the alumni who are working in the domain of their interests and thus a student is able to gauge his/her performance and prepare for the summer internships as per the feedback.

### **SAMPARK 6.0**

Sampark 6.0 was organized from September 10th, 2018 to September 16th, 2018 in the form of mock interviews and interactive sessions for PGP1 students by the Alumni (PGP 2011-2016) of IIM Udaipur who have the industry experience and are at the best position to provide valuable suggestions and advice. The alumni took out time of their busy schedule to help the PGP1 students in getting prepared for their first big step towards the placements.

In the past, Sampark programme has not only helped the students in securing good summer placements but also facilitated the interaction of PGP1's with the alumni in the IIMU Community. The IIMU community has always worked as a family since its inception and to further strengthen this bond, Team A4 takes pride in organizing such endeavors.

Sampark 6.0 was conducted at just the right time for the PGP1 students who were under the dilemma with fast approaching summer internship placements that started from Sept 26th, 2018. It helped them attain a better clarity of thought regarding the technicalities involved in the interview processes at IIMU. It also bridged the communication gap between the students and the alumni and provided a mentor for the students for their IIMU journey.

### **SAMPARK 6.1**

After the scintillating success of Sampark 6.0 and due to the multiple requests by PGP1 students, team A4 organized Sampark 6.1 on 22nd and 23rd Sept 2018. Students were impressed by the in-depth feedback given by the alumni and requested the team to conduct another round of interviews specifically for HR questions. The event was organized two days before the summer internship placements began. Team A4, with the wholehearted help and support from alumni, organized interviews for 250 students within a span of two days. The enthusiasm from alumni to help the students on such a short notice was immensely helpful for the students before their actual internship interviews.

### THE PROCESS

The first step was to float an interest form among the PGP1 students seeking their interest in Sampark mock interviews and interactive session. 183 PGP1s expressed their willingness to participate. We collected stream interest and resumes from the candidates.

Then, we floated an interest form to the alumni community seeking their help for the interviews and interactive sessions. 71 alumni positively responded to our request. We asked them their area of expertise so that we can map the students accordingly.

We scheduled the interviews, shared the resume of the students with the alumni and arranged interaction sessions through video conferencing on Skype or Google Hangouts and telephonic interviews as per the convenience of the alumni and the candidates.

An interview for each PGP1 was organized followed by a feedback session. Feedback sessions were time-independent and solely relied on the mutual satisfaction of PGP1 candidates and the alumni. PGP1s took great advantage of this opportunity by asking all their queries freely, regarding their career choices, industry, formal and informal tips. The alumni also gave suggestion on how to frame the answers in a better way and how to improve the resume.




