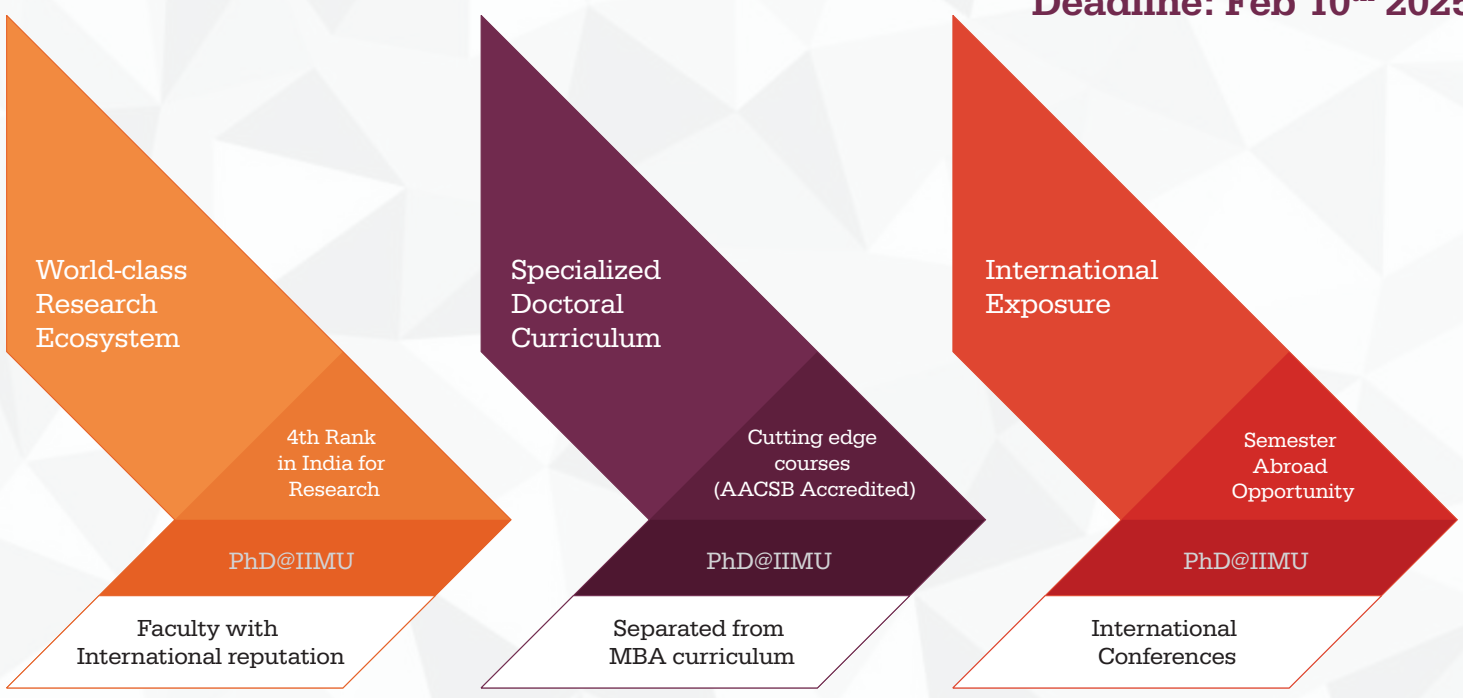

Applications Open for the Fully-funded Doctoral Program in Management

IIM Udaipur's PhD Program is a five-year, full-time program designed for students with strong academic credentials who aspire to become globally acclaimed scholars in their field. Students earning a PhD in management from IIM Udaipur will be well-equipped for a rewarding career in academia, enabled with the ability to undertake independent and impactful management research.

IIM Udaipur offers Ph.D. in five areas. A candidate can apply to only one area out of the five areas mentioned below:

- Decision Sciences
- Finance and Accounting
- Marketing
- Operations Management
- Organizational Behavior and Human Resource Management

- IIM Udaipur's AACSB-accredited PhD program aligns with top global business schools, offering an advanced, individualized curriculum.
- Our PhD curriculum, distinct from the MBA program, provides specialized training in advanced research skills, approaches, and subject areas, ensuring a high level of expertise and personalized faculty attention.

INTERNATIONAL EXPOSURE AND NETWORKING

- **Semester Abroad (Merit-Based):** IIMU sponsors up to two merit-based students annually to spend four months at a prestigious foreign university. They collaborate with esteemed faculty, engage in research, and enjoy full financial support. This exclusive opportunity sets IIMU apart from other IIMs.
- **International Conferences:** PhD students receive INR 2,00,000 over four years to attend international conferences and seminars, promoting global perspectives and connections. Additionally, an extra INR 2,00,000 funding is available for co-authoring papers accepted in top journals during the program.

FINANCIAL SUPPORT

- There are no course fees for PhD students.
- A generous monthly stipend of ₹ 37,000 (first 2 years), ₹ 40,000 on clearing comprehensive exam, and ₹ 44,000 after proposal defense.
- Contingency grants, starting with INR 50,000 in the first year and INR 25,000 annually from the second to fifth years.
- A one-time allowance of up to INR 50,000 is provided for a laptop/PC, with the option to use up to INR 25,000 from the first year's stationery grant for this purpose.
- Research grants of INR 150,000 are available for conducting thesis-related research.

CAMPUS ACCOMMODATION

- Single, semi-furnished, air-conditioned hostel accommodation (or equivalent) is provided at no charge.
- A married hostel is in the planning stage and expected to be ready by 2026. Meanwhile, married students can receive a monthly rental subsidy for off-campus housing with their families.

ELIGIBILITY

- A 1-year/2-semester master's degree programme after a 4-year/8-semester bachelor's degree programme or a year/4-semester master's degree programme after a 3-year bachelor's degree programme or qualifications declared equivalent to the master's degree by the corresponding statutory regulatory body, with at least 60% marks in aggregate or its equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed. This cutoff is 55 percent marks for applicants from SC, ST and PwD categories. (or)
- A five-year Integrated Master's degree (obtained after completing higher secondary schooling in 10+2 pattern) in any discipline with at least 60% marks in aggregate or its equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed. This cutoff is 55 percent marks for applicants from SC, ST and PwD categories. (or)
- A professional qualification (completed) such as CA (ICAI), ICWA, CS with a Bachelor's degree with at least 60 percent marks. This cutoff is 55 percent marks for applicants from SC, ST and PwD categories. (or)
- A 4-year/8-semester Bachelor's degree with equivalent of 75 percent marks in aggregate or its equivalent grade on a point scale wherever the grading system is followed. This cutoff is 70 percent marks for applicants from SC, ST and PwD categories.

Final-year candidates who have not yet completed their respective degrees (Bachelor's or Master's) by the application closing date are eligible to apply for the PhD program and can receive provisional acceptance.
