



IIM Udaipur Hosts 8th JAAF - ATP India Symposium



IIM Udaipur successfully hosted the **8th JAAF – ATP India Symposium** on January 11-12, 2025, organized by the **JM Financial Centre for Financial Research** in collaboration with ISB, IIM Ahmedabad, IIM Bangalore, and IIM Calcutta. The event was supported by **JM Financial Ltd.**, the Journal of Accounting, Auditing, and Finance, the Accounting Theory and Practice Journal, and ACCA.

The symposium began with an inaugural ceremony, followed by a **panel discussion on** 'Technological Innovation, The AI Wave, and its Implications for Business Education and Practice' featuring esteemed speakers from Rutgers Business School, Deloitte India, and IIT Bombay.

Over two days, **eight research papers** were presented on diverse topics, including **labor threats, financial misreporting, creditor rights, and reputation damage in capital markets**. Researchers from **IIMs, ISB, IIT Bombay, and global institutions** participated in discussions.

The symposium facilitated **insightful academic interactions**, reinforcing IIM Udaipur's commitment to **advancing research in accounting and finance**. The event concluded with **closing remarks and a networking session**, fostering collaboration between academia and industry.

The Indian Institute of Management, Udaipur (IIMU), hosted the second edition of *D'Future:* India Digital Conclave 2025 on January 17, 2025, at Jio World Convention Centre, Mumbai. Centered on "Beyond AI: The Next Frontier in Digital Transformation," the event brought together policymakers, business leaders, researchers, and entrepreneurs to explore the evolving digital landscape.

Prof. Ashok Banerjee, Director, IIM Udaipur, delivered the inaugural address, emphasizing IIMU's commitment to sustainability and innovation. The conclave also explored AI's role in entertainment and startups, concluding with a vision for collaborative digital innovation, reinforcing IIM Udaipur's leadership in shaping India's digital future.

IIM Udaipur Hosts Inaugural Roundtable of JM Financial Centre for Financial Research on 'India @2047: The Role of BFSI'




The Indian Institute of Management Udaipur (IIM Udaipur) hosted the inaugural Roundtable of the JM Financial Centre for Financial Research, bringing together industry leaders to discuss the Banking, Financial Services, and Insurance (BFSI) sector's role in shaping India's economic future. Themed *India* @2047: The Role of BFSI, the discussion focused on financial inclusion, sustainability, real estate growth, insurance expansion, and capital markets.

Mudit Jain (Head of Research, TATA Capital) emphasized the role of clean technology in financial sustainability, highlighting the need for investment in mitigation and adaptation strategies. Amit Goenka (CMD, Nisus Finance) discussed India's real estate boom, projecting 50% urbanization in the next 4-5 years. Casparus Kromhout (MD & CEO, Shriram Life Insurance) explored the growth of India's insurance sector, stressing the need to expand coverage to 1.1 billion people by 2047. Sonia Dasgupta (MD & CEO, JM Financial) highlighted India's capital market expansion, while Rajesh Rai (Business Head, ICICI Bank) examined global banking trends and India's digital economy.



About IIM Udaipur

IIM Udaipur is well on its way to becoming a globally recognised B-School. It has broken new ground by focusing on world-class research and transforming students into tomorrow's managers and leaders. The Institute arrived on the global education stage by securing accreditation from the AACSB (Association to Advance Collegiate Schools of Business) in merely eight years of its establishment. With this accreditation, IIM Udaipur is counted in the same league of global institutes, such as Harvard Business School, Wharton School at the University of Pennsylvania, and the MIT Sloan School. IIMU has been listed on the Financial Times (FT) Global MIM Ranking 2024 for the 6th consecutive year, making it the only IIM to have achieved this feat. In the OS Global MIM Ranking 2025, IIM Udaipur stands as the 6th highest-ranked IIM and continues to maintain its listing for the 6th year in a row, reinforcing its global standing. Notably, it is also the youngest B-School in the world to be featured in both rankings. Additionally, IIM Udaipur ranks 4th in India for research in management, according to the UT Dallas methodology, which tracks publications in leading global journals, showcasing its excellence in academic research.
